Figure 1 - 1: Racial/Ethnic Composition over Time

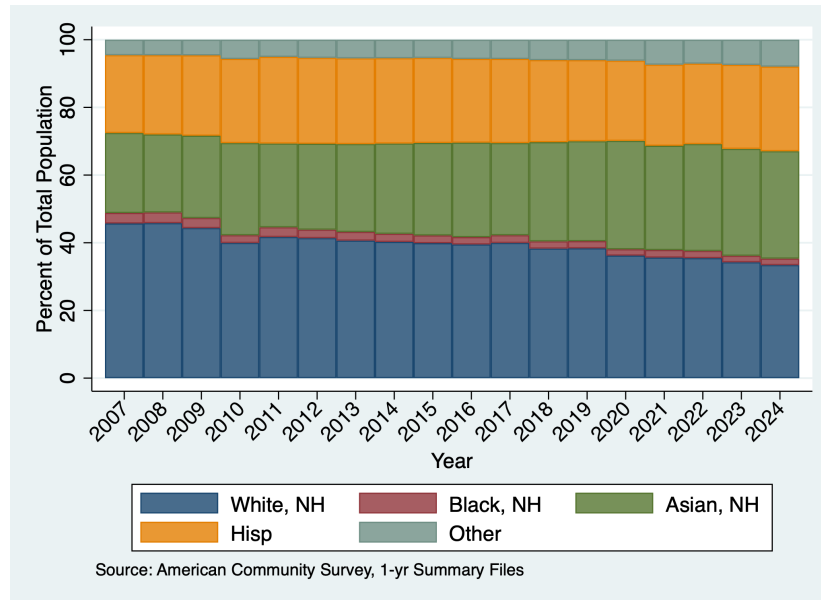

Figure 2 - 1: Labor Force Participation Rates

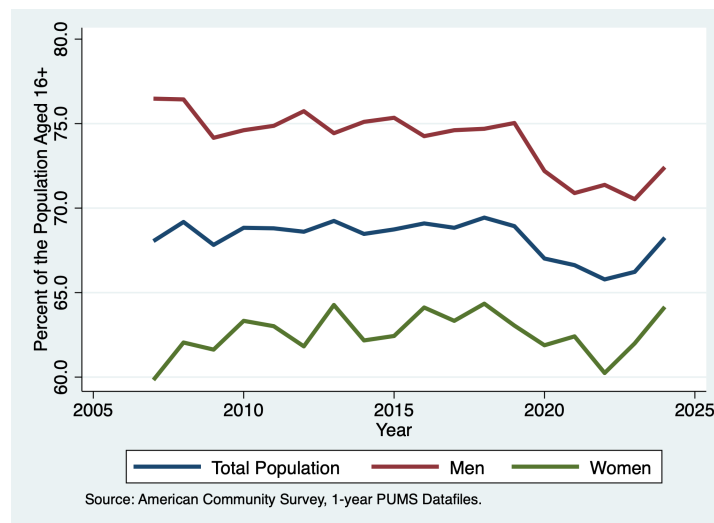

Figure 5 - 1: Educational Attainment Over Time

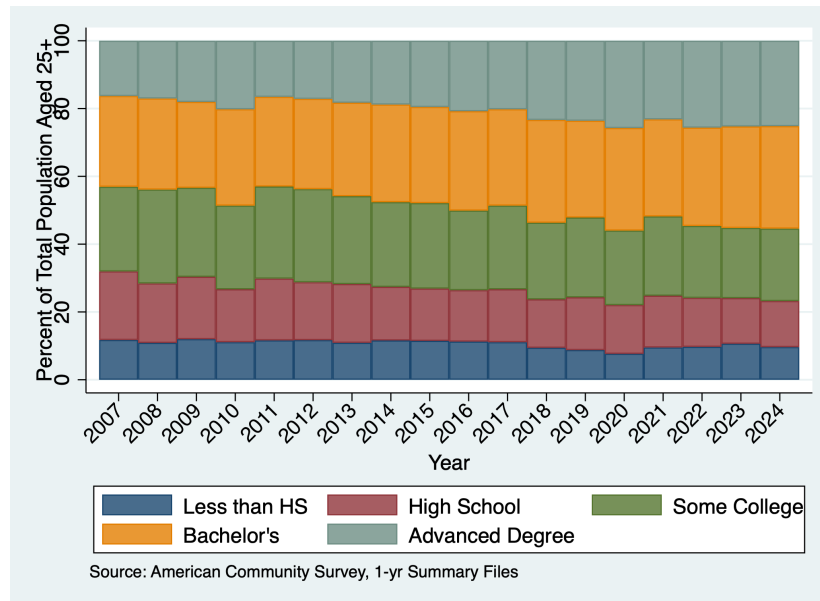

Figure 7 - 1: Mobility Trends Over Time

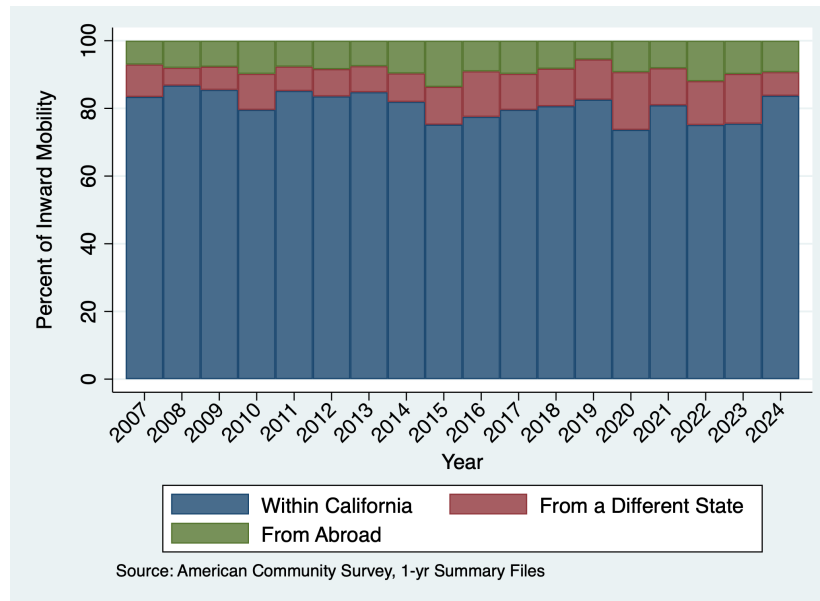
