Definition of Personal Income

Personal income is the income received by, or on behalf of, all persons from all sources: from participation as laborers in production, from owning a home or unincorporated business, from the ownership of financial assets, and from government and business in the form of transfer receipts. It includes income from domestic sources as well as from the rest of the world.

Personal income is the income that is available to persons for consumption expenditures, taxes, interest payments, transfer payments to governments and the rest of the world, or for saving.

The data in this report have been adjusted for inflation into 2024 \$ using the: Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers: All Items.

Figure 1 - 1: Real Per Capita Personal Income - Comparables (Rank)

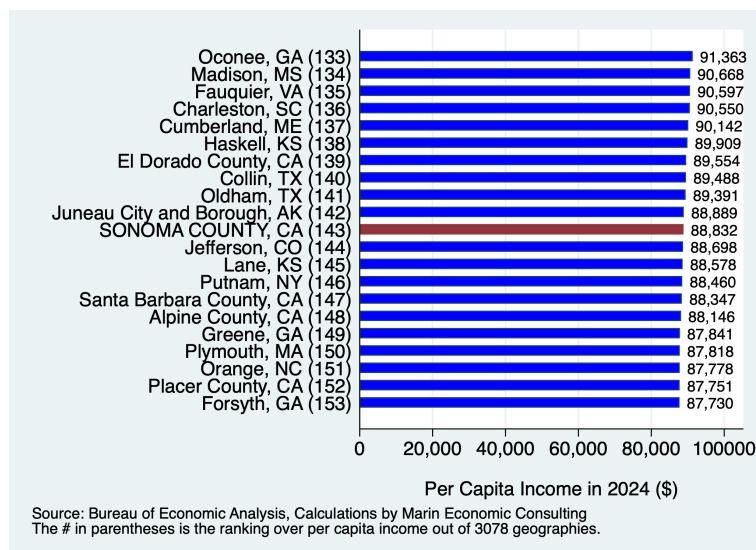
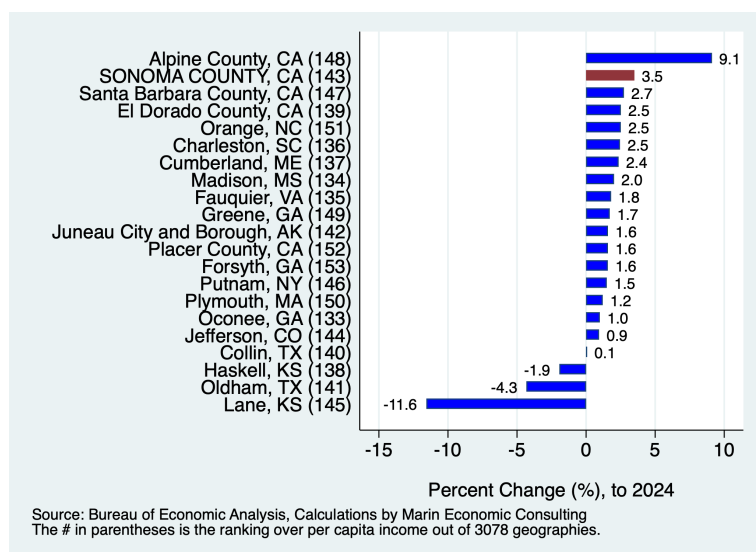


Figure 1 - 2: Year over Year Growth in Real Per Capita Personal Income - Comparables (Rank by Absolute Income Level)

Figure 2 - 2: Real Per Capita Personal Income - Last 10 Years

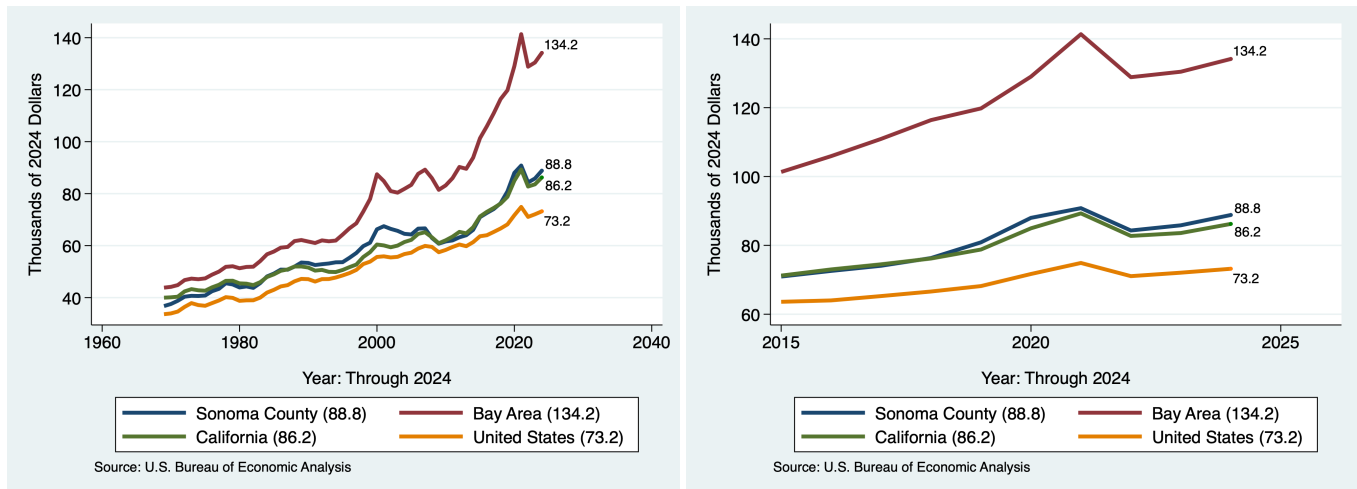


Figure 2 - 3: Growth in Real Per Capita Personal Income

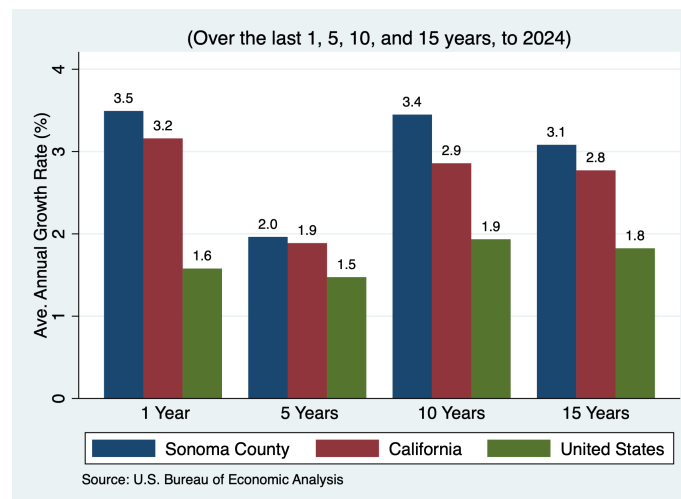

Figure 3 - 1: Total Real Personal Income - History

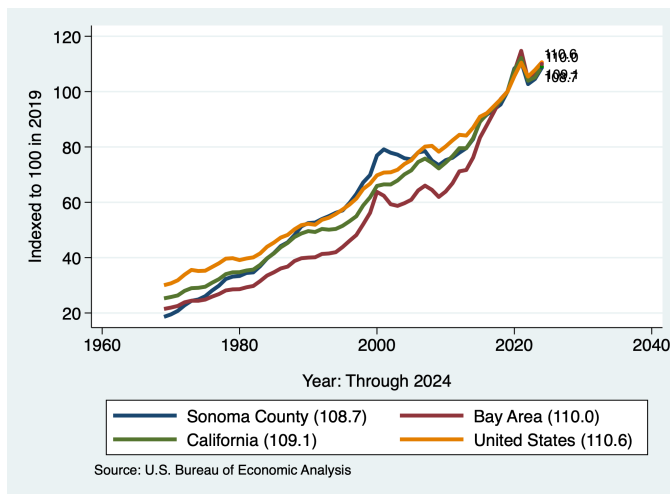


Figure 3 - 2: Total Real Personal Income - Last 10 years

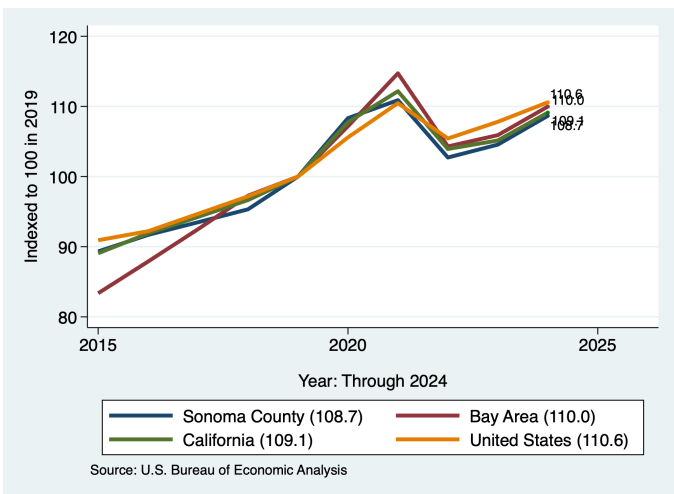


Figure 3 - 3: Growth in Total Real Personal Income

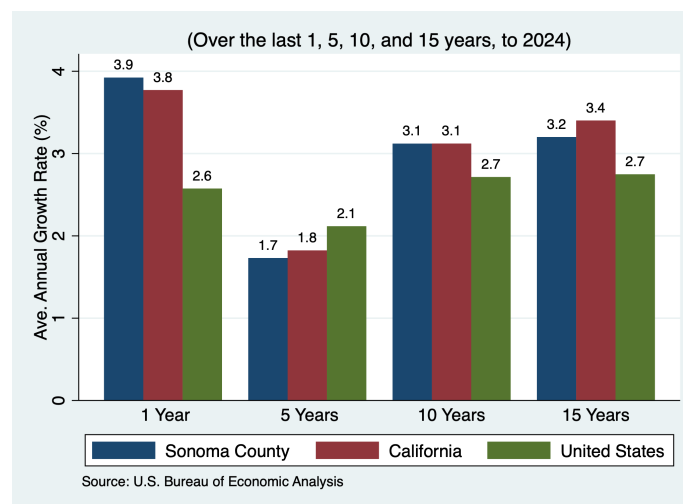

Figure 4 - 1: Population - History

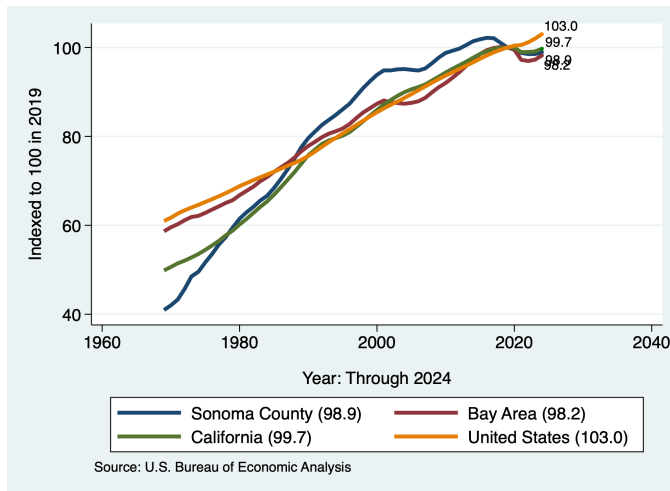


Figure 4 - 2: Population - Last 10 Years

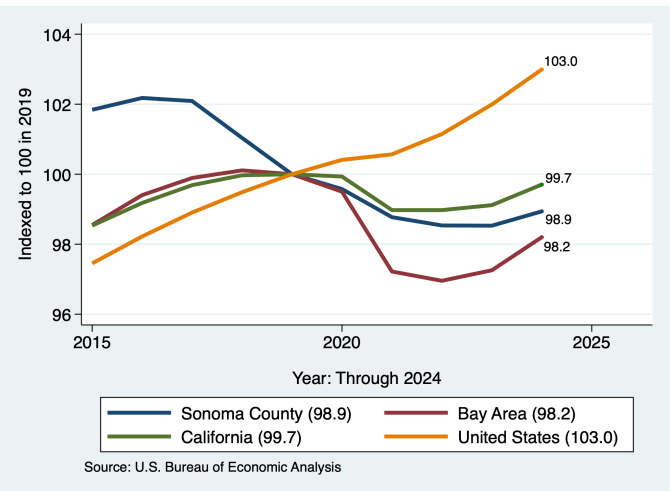


Figure 4 - 3: Average Annual Population Growth

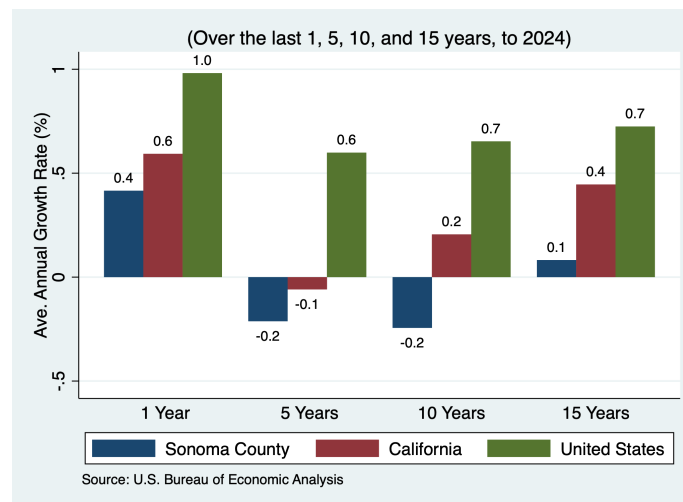
